

Volunteer Drivers

Fresh food and non-perishables are donated weekly to the Halton Children's Aid Society (Halton CAS) by local sources for distribution to families in need. The objective is to get the food to the client(s) as quickly as possible to ensure the best quality. This is an incredibly important volunteer position as families in our community rely on you for this weekly service. A team of volunteers are required to assist in sorting and bagging the food, while other volunteers are required to deliver the food to clients.

 Provide fresh and non-perishable food to families in our community who need support. Sort, bag and deliver food to families referred to this program by Halton CAS workers. 	 Minimum of one to two hours per week. Every Wednesday from 10:00 am to 12:00 pm.

 Receive, sort and bag fresh and non-perishable foods into individual grocery bags. Ensure proper food safety handling procedures are followed. Ensure quality of food is good. Check expiry dates of non-perishables. Prepare bags for delivery. Deliver food to families in the community. Maintain a professional and caring manner as a representative of Halton CAS. Motivate other volunteers to follow your example. Adhere to the guidelines of the Halton CAS Code of Conduct. 	 Knowledge of the Halton area. Possess a valid Ontario Driver's Licence and a safe driving record. Have a safe, reliable and insured vehicle. Confidentiality is a must. Good verbal communication skills. Complete a Vulnerable Sector Screening. Patience, sense of humour and caring personality.
